Problem-Based Learning (PBL)

PBL is a student-centered teaching method that uses clinical cases to help students develop critical thinking and clinical reasoning skills. PBL groups include one faculty facilitator and 8-11 students. You will foster an environment for students to independently identify their learning needs, improve differential diagnoses, problem-solving abilities, and lifelong learning. PBL groups meet 2-3 times weekly for 2 hours, from 10 am - noon or 1 – 3 pm, depending on the course and year. **Facilitators DO NOT need to be subject matter experts and do not lecture!!** Anyone with a PhD, MD, or DO is encouraged to sign up.

Small Group Facilitation (Doctoring & Clinical Skills 1 and 2)

These groups are run by clinical faculty (MD/DO), where you will facilitate practice sessions for students (sometimes with standardized patients) to learn physical examination skills, oral presentation and interview skills, as well as discuss ethical, professional, and scientific issues in healthcare. These two-hour small group sessions occur up to 11-12 times over the academic year.

What's new this year?

- **Facilitator Training:** All facilitators must complete updated training to align with JSSOM objectives.
- **Small Groups:** Clinical courses are now part of the longitudinal DoCS curriculum.
 - DoCS MS1 begins 8/11/2025; DoCS MS2 begins 7/14/2025.
- **PBL:** MS1 PBL starts 10/27/2025; MS2 PBL starts 7/21/2025.
- **RFE:** Offered twice in AY 25/26 (Years 1 and 2), faculty may participate in one or both.

Compensation:

Compensation is 0.05 tFTE (or 5% of your salary) inclusive of all PBL/Small group sessions for all courses. Please see the table below for specific information on PBL /small group dates for each course.
